

GFWC FLORIDA VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR AWARD Nomination

The GFWC Florida Volunteer of the Year Award is annually given to one woman's club member who best exemplifies outstanding service through volunteerism. This award includes service rendered through the GFWC Florida, but also includes volunteer efforts in other organizations as well, including other civic, fraternal and religious organizations. The recipient of this award is a member who has given unselfishly of her time and energy for worthwhile causes, to better her community and her world, and to help others. Volunteer work must have been performed during this calendar year (January 1 - December 31).

Each club may nominate one member for this award. The nominations must be sent to the District Membership Chairman, postmarked no later than February 1. A district nominee will be selected in each of the 14 districts by a committee of three: the District Membership chairman, the District Director and the District Leadership chairman. In the event any of these committee members is a nominee, the District Membership Chairman will select alternate committee member(s) to serve (Junior District Director or other District Chairman). The District Membership Chairman will be responsible for overseeing the selection and will forward the application of her district's nominee to the GFWC Florida Second Vice President, postmarked no later than February 15. The GFWC Florida Executive Committee will make the final selection of the Volunteer of the Year. Each of 14 nominees will receive a paid registration to the Convention where they will be recognized and the recipient announced.

CRITERIA: Include this page and attach a 2-page narrative/resume, typewritten or computer generated, double spaced with size 10 font or larger. Explain why this member is being nominated; why she is deserving of this recognition. It is suggested that the narrative/resume include her achievements and involvement in the GFWC Florida and achievements and involvement in her community through other organizations. Only volunteer efforts for the immediate calendar year (January 1 - December 31) may be included. Volunteer efforts that are directly related to her job may not be included. Members of the GFWC Florida Executive Committee are not eligible for this award.
