

# One Voice for Children and W.H.A.L.E.

What is a W.H.A.L.E. Program? The WHALE Program (We Have A Little Emergency) is a Child Safety Seat Identification Program. This is the first of it's kind in the United States, the stickers provide useful information to rescue personnel in the event the adult(s) in the vehicle is incapacitated.

The WHALE stickers are placed in the window, visible to the rescue personnel. The Identification Label is attached to the rear of the safety seat and contains pertinent information of the child (name, date of birth, medical history, and emergency contacts).

FFWC WHALE Kits include: Identification Label (for rear of car seat), two WHALE stickers (for side of car seat) and two optional window clings (if car seat is placed in various vehicles).

We have done all the work, all we ask is that you use this tool to help  
***Spread the Word*** about children's safety!
