EPSILON SIGMA OMICRON

The Epsilon Sigma Omicron Division of the GFWC Florida Federation of Women's Clubs is an honorary educational sorority for Florida club women who desire to continue their education through planned reading, after their conventional schooling is over, and who seek direction in it. The sorority is non-social and non-secret with culture as its sole air. It is a cooperative venture in Adult Education, and has represented the combined efforts of General Federation of Women's Clubs, and the GFWC Florida Federation of Women's Clubs.

PURPOSE

The plan has a four-fold purpose:

1. To stimulate systematic home reading and study, with a minimum of supervision.
2. To encourage a wiser and wider use of public libraries.
3. To encourage the formation of reading groups for study.
4. To make ESO a vital force in today's adult education movement.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership in this sorority is composed of women who are members of per capita paying clubs in the GFWC Florida Federation of Women's Clubs and who have completed and earned certificates. Certificates of membership are presented by the GFWC Florida Federation of Women's Clubs. Members of clubs who signify their intention of reading by enrolling in ESO course are considered pledges of the sorority. Membership in ESO is individual.

READING GROUPS

Many clubs have reading groups which meet regularly to discuss or review ESO books. A club having such a group is awarded at the end of the club year a certificate of merit. No person can meet regularly with an ESO group unless she has obtained her membership or has enrolled in a reading course.

HOME READING COURSES

For the convenience of members of the GFWC Florida Federation of Women's Clubs, more than twenty-five courses with a variety of subjects have been provided. A reader may select any four of the courses offered to qualify for membership in ESO.

In order to complete a Reading Course, the reader completes all five of the books she has selected in a chosen category, and sends her reports to the ESO State Chairman. When the course has been satisfactorily completed, the reader is entitled to a certificate, and upon completion of four courses, she has

earned a certificate of membership in the ESO of the GFWC Florida Federation of Women's Clubs, and is entitled to buy and wear the pin. Any member who has earned sixteen reading course certificates may add a guard to her pin.

HOW TO ENROLL

A charge of \$5.00 for the series book and unlimited reporting will be initiated. Book Listings with Annotations are for the permanent file, and should be written or typed. This form may be obtained from the ESO Chairman of GFWC Florida. The current chairman is:

Individual Enrollment fee is \$5.00 paid annually and may be made through you local club ESO Chairman, or a check may be sent for \$5.00 per person, made out to GFWC Florida and mailed along with a pledge form, to the State ESO Chairman.

AWARDS

Course Name: Same Author

How Used: You may read 5 books by an author listed or not listed. Use as often as desired.

Course # O-31A

Course Name: Paper Chase

How Used: Most Recent Best Sellers not yet listed in booklet. Use only once each level first Century. May use 5 times each century thereafter.

All reading lists from previous years are still approved.

You may substitute a book not listed for a listed book written by the same author.

Books may be hard cover, soft cover or pocket books.

A COURSE IS 5 BOOKS. A book with MORE than 500 pages counts as two books. A book with 1000 pages or more, count as three books. Large Print Books over 750 pages count as two books. **(PLEASE, Only one to a course.)**

ESO History

Epsilon Sigma Omicron was founded by Mrs. Quincy A. Myers in 1928 assisted by Indiana University and organized as a project of the Adult Education Division of the Indiana Federation of Clubs. ESO affiliated with GFWC in 1934. GFWC Florida was the eighteenth state to be granted its charter, Sigma Chapter, in 1953.

THE ESO CREST

Bertha J. Lacey, a well-known Indian artist, designed the ESO Crest in the form of a shield, the ancient symbol of protection. The shield is divided into sections, and is crowned with a DOVE OF PEACE, and below the Crest is the TORSADE, bearing the name "Epsilon Sigma Omicron."

The sections bear symbols, representing home, enlightenment, effort, fine arts and a book symbolizing knowledge. The wheat denotes the idea that we reap what we sow.
