Programs involving persons with any of the following special needs or disabilities, or other programs that you may determine to be for a special need or special ability, are all eligible.

Programs are encouraged to be interactive, engaging our special needs community with our hands and hearts. Some areas of Special Needs where your club may develop a project are listed here.

1. Persons with Physical Disabilities
2. Medical special needs such as Diabetes or Cancer
3. Age related special needs such as Alzheimer's
4. Organ Transplant in Children and Adults
5. The Blind or visually impaired
6. The Deaf or hearing impaired
7. Disabled or Wounded Veterans
8. Developmental Special Needs such as Autism
9. Cognitive or Learning Disabilities
10. Emotional Special Needs
11. Mental Health Special Needs
12. Elderly or Nursing Homes
13. Foster Homes or Orphanages
14. Speech Impairments
15. Homeless or Shelters
16. Progressive conditions such as Multiple Sclerosis or Muscular Dystrophy
17. OneBlood blood drives with education on blood donation
